

Corporate Coordinated Graffiti Abatement Program FAQs

Program Overview	What Information do I need to report graffiti on my property?	What is the cost of the graffiti abatement program?
<ul style="list-style-type: none">•Property owners have 14 days to remove graffiti from their property.•If you are not able to remove the graffiti yourself you can request assistance from the City of Calgary•Calgary City Council has approved limited funds to assist needy Calgarians with the cost of removing graffiti.•Property owners must sign a waiver authorizing a City contractor to enter the property to remove graffiti.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">•Address•Specific location on property•Description of graffiti (what it says or looks like, colour of paint used, etc.)•If possible, e-mail pictures to PGAP@calgary.ca	<ul style="list-style-type: none">•There is no cost to property owners.•There are limited funds available for this program.•The City of Calgary reserves the right to decline to provide service in exceptional circumstances.
Why wouldn't I have the City remove it for free?	How do I remove the graffiti myself?	Who do I contact to sign up for the program?
<ul style="list-style-type: none">•One of the best deterrents for graffiti is speedy removal. The faster an owner can remove the graffiti the lower the chance of reoccurrence.•City crews will typically take longer to remove graffiti.•Property owners have greater control if they take responsibility themselves.•There are limited funds available for this program.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">•You can paint over the graffiti.•There are a number of graffiti removal products available for purchase from paint suppliers and retailers.•You can hire a contractor yourself.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">•Please call 3-1-1•Please visit www.calgary.ca/bylaws for more information.
